How has your school's spending increased pupil PE and sport activity levels?	Children are actively engaged in a minimum of 60 minutes of physical activity each day due to our break and lunch time offer. Children have a variety of opportunities to be physically active throughout the school day based on our implementation strategy.
How has your school's spending increased pupil participation in extra-curricular activities?	Children have had multiple opportunities to take part in extra-curricular opportunities that they would not usually have access to. This includes bespoke football coaching provided by Darlington Football Club Foundation, high quality gymnastics and dance coaching from experienced, well-qualified external providers.
How has your school's spending increased staff training and continued professional development (CPD)?	Staff have been provided with training specific to the schools aims. This has allowed staff to embed these principles within their lessons, ensuring children are consistently receiving physical education lessons of a high quality which is both knowledge and skill rich.
How has your school's spending improved swimming attainment?	Those children who have not been able to achieve swimming proficiency or confidence have had extra opportunities to develop this. Subsequently, we have ensured that more children are able to be confident in water while also securely swimming 25m.

All children have received a water safety assembly from an external provider who demonstrated the importance of water safety within our local area. Funding has also ensured many of those who were unable to demonstrate basic water safety skills in swimming lessons have had further opportunities to develop this through top-up lessons.
