• **Theme:** Self portrait

• **Key Artist:** Gustav Klimt

• **Skills Developed:** line work, proportion

• **Tools:** 2H Sketch pencils. A range of tissue paper to create a background for their line work sketch.

Year 2 - Sketching

• Theme: Flowers

• Key Artist: Shaun Tan

• **Skills Developed:** Sketching using shade and light

• **Tools:** 2H pencil and 6B sketch pencil.



























Year 3 - Sketching

• Theme: Fruit bowl perspective art

• **Key Artist:** J D Hillberry

• **Skills Developed:** Sketching using shade and light focusing on perspective of a fruit bowl and positioning of light depending on where they are sitting.

• **Tools:** 2H pencil, HB pencil and 6B sketch pencil.



Year 4 - Sketching

 Theme: Landscape perspective art with a focus on background and foreground.

• **Key Artist:** Robert Longo

 Skills Developed: Sketching using shade and light focusing on background and foreground to create depth.

Tools: Sketch pencils: 2H, HB, 6B and charcoal.





Year 5 - Sketching

• **Theme:** Animal features

• Key Artist: Henri Rousseau

• **Skills Developed :** Sketching skills with increased precision. Adding colour to create shade/ light and texture.

• Tools: Sketch pencils: 2H 2B HB, 6B and coloured pencils and chalks (children may not need all sketch pencils but give them the option to choose from)



Year 6 - Sketching

• **Theme:** Self portrait

• **Key Artist:** Kelvin Okafor

 Skills Developed: Adding shade and light with increased detail.
Blending/ layering different medium to create texture.

Tools: Sketch pencils: All 6 sketch pencils, chalk, charcoal and oil pastels (children may not need all sketch pencils but give them the option to choose from).





Year 1 Painting

Theme: Shape

• Key Artist: Wassili Kandinski

Skills Developed: Colour mixing secondary colours

 Tools: Medium brushes and waterbased paints




Year 2 Painting

• Theme: Pattern/ colour blending

• **Key Artist:** Martin Bulinya

 Skills Developed: Blending background using warm colours. Wax resist to create pattern on people's outfits and sketch/paint people's bodies.

 Tools: Water based colours, sponges, brushes, Sketch pencils.





Year 3 Painting

• Theme: Pattern - Rainforest art

• Key Artist: Nixiwaka Yawanawá

 Skills Developed: Colour mixing and artist inspired pattern/ secondary/ tertiary


• **Tools:** Water based paint, different thickness of brushes to create detail.





Year 4 Painting

- Theme: Increasing detail using pattern
 - **Key Artist:** Beatriz Milhazes
- **Skills Developed:** detailed shape, pattern and contrasting mixed colours
 - **Tools:** Paint, a variety of brushes





Year 5 Painting

• Theme: Landscape

• Key Artist: Claude Monet

• **Skills Developed:** Mixing muted colours, small brush stroke technique, blending, creating silhouette.

• **Tools:** 3 primary colours, black/white paint, fine brushes



Year 6 Painting

- Theme: Landscape and pattern
- **Key Artist:** Vincent Van Gogh
- Skills Developed: Detailed/precise brush strokes using tertiary colours with a focus on contrasting colours. Light/ dark, warm/ cool, Bright/ dull
 - Tools: precise brushes, paint





YEAR I SCULPTURE

• **Theme:** Paper Sculpture

• **Key Artist:** Michael Bolus

• **Skills Developed:** Paper sculpting techniques including folding, twirling, bending, twisting, fanning, curling etc.

 Tools: Coloured and Wrapping paper cut into various sizes and shapes.



YEAR 2 SCULPTURE

• **Theme:** Modroc Figurines

• **Key Artist:** Sean Henry

• Skills Developed: Using pipe cleaners to create simple bends, curls, twists, curves and sculpting with Modroc Plaster Bandages

• **Tools:** Pipe cleaners, Tin foil, ModRoc plaster bandages, Metallic paint





YEAR 3 SCULPTURE

• **Theme:** 2D to 3D Cardboard Balancing Sculptures

• **Key Artist:** Ben Nicholson

• **Skills Developed:** Cutting out simple shapes, block/pattern painting, balancing sculptures, creative thinking/problem solving.

• **Tools:** Metal ruler, Stanley knives, cutting boards, pliers, string, wire, scissors, paints.

YEAR A SCULPTURE

• Theme: Foam Birds and Modroc Eggs

 Key Artists: Cathy Miles and Diana Beltran-Herrera

• **Skills Developed:** Cutting foam shapes, using various drawing materials, creating collages, sculpting with various materials.

 Tools: Foam board, paper, glue, Modroc, newspaper, drawing materials, scissors





YEAR 5 SCULPTURE

• Theme: Clay Tessellation

• **Key Artists:** M. C. Escher, William Morris and Henry Moore

 Skills Developed: Clay sculpting, creating patterns and tessellations, observational drawing, rubbing and tracing, painting

• **Tools:** Clay, acrylic paint, PVA glue, thin paper, coloured pencils



YEAR 6 SCULPTURE

• **Theme:** Modroc Memory Pots

• **Key Artists:** Clarice Cliff

 Skills Developed: Constructing multipart pots, cutting shapes, drawing and colouring patterns, sculpting with modroc.

• **Tools:** Modroc, balloons, scissors, tissue paper, oil pastels, graphite, PVA glue
