School uniform

As we are nearing the end of the summer term, and parents will be starting to think about purchasing uniform for next year, we would like to remind all our parents about our uniform policy. Our uniform consists of; black or grey trousers/skirts/pinafore or summer dresses (green and white or yellow and white), white polo shirt, bottle green sweatshirt or cardigan, black flat shoes.

PE kit should be plain **black** shorts or jogging bottoms, white t-shirt, plain black or bottle green sweatshirts or cardigans, plimsols or trainers.

All long hair should be tied back and only single stud earrings should be worn. For health and safety reasons we do not allow any other jewellery other than a watch if they can tell the time.

We kindly remind parents that only school book bags should be brought into school, as these fit safely on our storage trolleys. Book bags are available to purchase from the school office. Small packed lunch bags are also permitted; however, backpacks should not be brought into school.

Our new uniform with the updated school logo is now available from our suppliers. Please note that these items should only be worn from September. Uniform with the previous logo can still be worn, and there is no expectation for children to wear branded items—plain sweatshirts and cardigans are absolutely acceptable.
